## Contracts



Working with Yorkshire Water we are looking at energy saving on drive systems and are in the middle of energy trials on a scheme where the savings are proving to be around 35%. Following the completion of these trials we then plan to roll out a pro-active investigation on all sites where similar savings can be made.

Our MCC and Control Panel activity has been very busy manufacturing panels for power stations in China and America. The special coated panels will form an integral part of the stations hydraulically controlled valves and will be integrated into their automated boiler control system.



This month we are also pleased to have been awarded M&E schemes to the value of £400k within United Utilities through their civil partners. We have also been contracted to undertake the design works of several major pumping schemes which will include pump and pipe work sizing calculations.
